

Monitoring checklist for Amnesty websites – May 24. 2021

- 1. Is the website uncluttered and the navigation clear?
- 2. Does the website include a brief description about Amnesty's work?
- 3. Does the official logo appear on the website?
- 4. Is the naming of the website clear?
- 5. Can the group be contacted via an e-mail address?
- 6. Does the website have a link to amnesty.nl and a link to sign up as a member or donator?
- 7. Is the website free of uncontrolled advertising?
- 8. Is the website up to date?
- 9. Is 'date of last change' displayed on home page?
- 10. Are there any articles, not from Amnesty, whose source is not listed?
- 11. Is the website technically sound and are all links correct?
- 12. Is any confidential information handled correctly?
- 13. Does the website comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (in Dutch: AVG)?
- 14. Does the website comply with Amnesty's cookie guidelines?

Points of attention:

- Are cookies placed before approval?
- Does the website state what data is collected and for what purposes?
- Is it mentioned with which external parties the data will be shared and how long the data will be stored?
- Is a cookie wall used, so that the visitor cannot see the site until the pop-up is clicked away?
- How is the tracking data collected? Only by cookies, or also by scripts or beacons such as tracking pixels?
